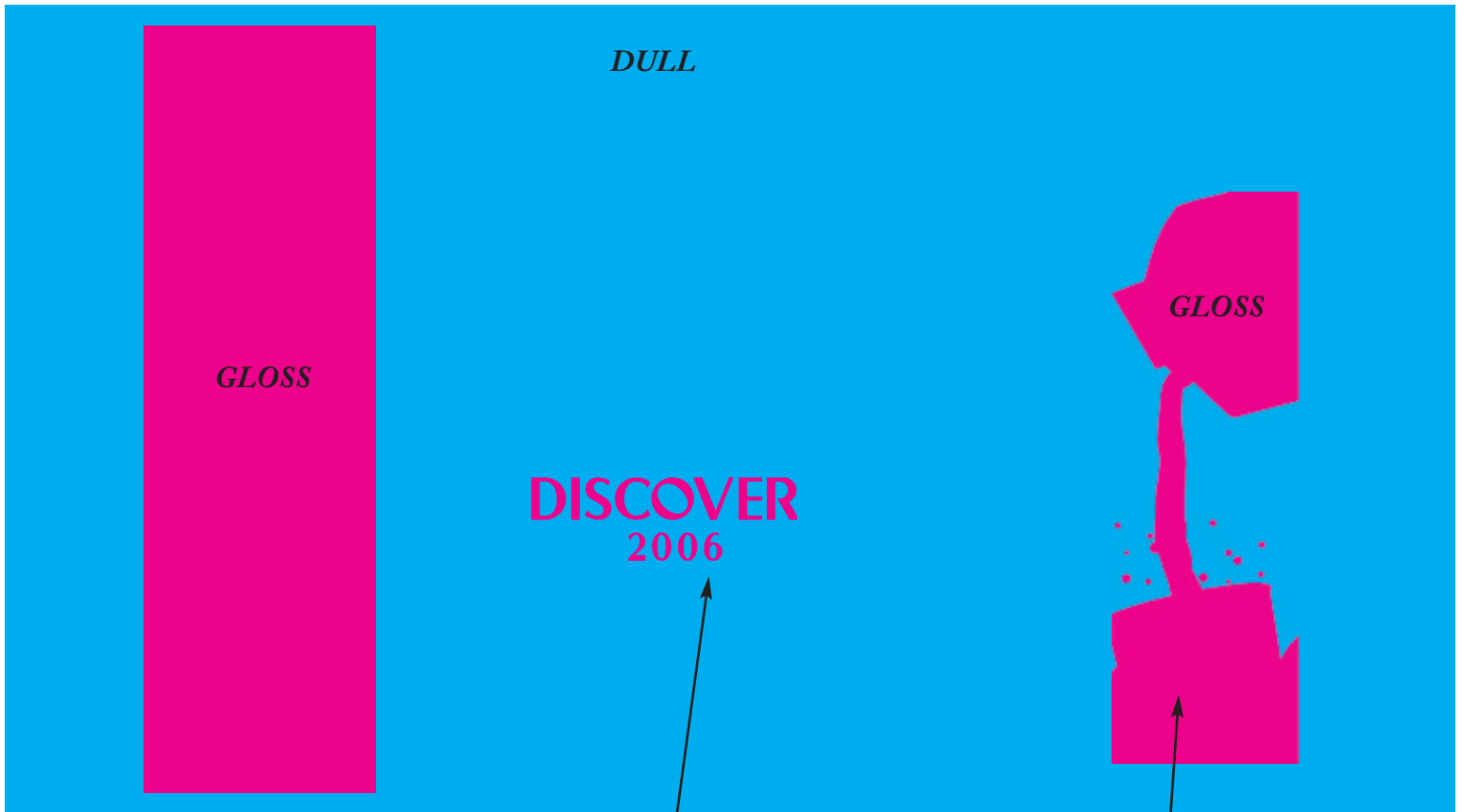


To create a spot-coating layer, please follow the step by step instructions:

1. Make a copy of your page layout file and name it “varnish”.
2. Delete everything, except the items you want to be spot gloss and/or dull coated.
3. Fill the items to be coated with a solid color. This can be magenta, cyan or a spot color. See illustration below.
4. Please note any silhouetted images that spot coat must be outlined in PhotoShop, if there are logos or illustrations created in Illustrator, you must separate the dull and the gloss in the Illustrator file using magenta, cyan or a spot color, any embedded images in Illustrator will not work unless the native embedded image is outlined and separated, then relinked in illustrator. Note: DO NOT outline images in illustrator using the pen tool as this will cause inaccurate outlines.
5. You are now able to view everything that will be spot coated.
